You will have seen recently in the media that as part of phase 2 of the easing of the lockdown restrictions, singles bowls will be allowed. Regretfully, the situation with our green is far from satisfactory. As mentioned in the last newsletter, the green is in a terrible state because of the leatherjacket infestation. The grounds men have only in the last week been able to cut the grass and it still needs scarifying, sanding, and re-sowing.
