### **GBC Green Usage Covid-19 Precautions**

- Players must always observe social distancing (1m)
- Maximum of 30 players on the green
- Clubhouse will only be used for toilet facilities
- Maximum of 4 people in the Clubhouse at any one time
- Rinks will be used as directed by the rink supervisor
- Match fees should be placed in the box provided before play commences
- Alcohol hand gel should be used on entering and leaving the green
- Dispose of all wipes, gloves and litter in an appropriate manner
- Avoid handling other players bowls. Use Alcohol wipes to clean surfaces touched
